


Farthingstone Foot Fest 5th June 2021

In the past, the Village Hall was used exclusively for the Farthingstone Foot Fest from registration to end certification and meal. However, due to the need to maintain social distancing because of the Covid 19 crisis, the FFF committee have decided to utilise the Joy Mead Gardens Cloisters to assist with the new requirements.

- 1) Participants will be asked to arrive at the Joy Mead Gardens as prepared as possible for their chosen event
- 2) The Participants will be sign-posted to the Registration Desk in the Joy Mead Garden Cloisters allowing for orderly – 2 metre - social distancing ‘under-cover’ queuing . Only 1 person at a time will be allowed at the registration desk (A barrier will be in-place)
- 3) At the registration desk, hand sanitiser will be available
- 4) The Registration Personnel and all Check Point Marshals will be conducting Covid safety measures and will have available Masks, Gloves and Sanitiser for use throughout
- 5) After Registration, the Entrant will exit via the side gate after registering their actual start time
- 6) Throughout the course, Participants will be asked – by instruction on the Route Description Sheets - to observe ‘social distancing’ at ‘pinch points’ i.e. Styles, Kissing Gates, Check Points etc.

7) Hand Sanitiser will be available at each Check Point

8) PLEASE NOTE: Participants MUST bring their own cup in order to limit risk of Covid spread

9) On completion, (The Registration Station in the Joymead Gardens is also the Final Check-in desk) the Participant to walk the short distance to the Village Hall for the after-event meal

a) In order to be fully Covid Safe and Compliant with the anticipated regulations on the day, the after-event food (Vegetarian and Vegan options will also be available) will be served at the Village Hall but regrettably we will not be able to permit eating on-site.

i. serving the food from a serving hatch - ensuring social distancing – into a container

ii. Please remember to wear face masks.

iii. Meals – together with a can of Beer / Lager or alternative to be taken away

iv. To comply with Covid regs anticipated for 5/6/21, No Eating or Drinking on-site

b) Participants will only be allowed entry if sufficient space available to maintain social distancing otherwise will be requested to remain and wait in Joy Mead until space becomes available.

c) After the Participant has received their meal, they must leave by the exit door and eat their meal away from the site
